The tasks of the programme

- disseminating practical knowledge among peers of similar age, giving advice, sharing knowledge, providing inspiration to take up new activities, lead healthy lifestyles, stay healthy, join communities,
- organising workshops, webinars, thematic group discussions, online and face-to-face presentations, hybrid trainings (online and in-person) for developing competencies in internet usage, improving digital literacy, encouraging lifelong learning, facilitating peer-to-peer knowledge transfer and accelerating the change of mindset in breaking down stereotypes about older people.

Means of implementing the programme

- Interactive, media rich information materials/learning materials/mini games developed in the SkillToolkit Live! training platform for surveying purposes and disseminating information,
- Using the SkillToolkit Live! training platform for organising online/blended/in-person trainings/events and managing their administration, documentation and reporting,
- Using development purpose digital materials for:
 - o synchronous online knowledge transfer, sensitisation, mentoring,
 - o creating contents for asynchronous digital literacy development.


Funding of the programme
